Vikash was established in 1986 and has now become a leading NGO of the state . Presently it is working with Disabled people in Puri & Koraput district . It is working with tribal communities in Naryanapatna, Pottangi & Lamtaput block of Koraput district & in Bonda hills in Malkanagiri district. It works on Urban issues in Konark Bhubaneswar, Rayagada & Kendrapara. It wishes to reach its services more to more disabled children and tribal households .

Vikash runs Residential Day care centre at Gop, Puri where 40 no of disabled children are supported with basic care, special education and therapy services. Aids and appliances are arranged for disabled children from Government schemes.

Our experience is that children with cerebral palsy can manage their daily living skills if they are adequately trained and oriented .Similarly Mentally challenged children can take care of themselves and be integrated into general schools if Prepared ` appropriately.

Inauguration of Village Development Committee Formation

Village development committees (VDC) have been formed in all the 48 revenue villages in Bonda Hills. The committees will prepare and execute the village development plans. The elected PRI representatives also participated in VDC meetings.

Paddy & Ragi Processing unit installed



Paddy & Raggi Processing units were set up in 30 Bonda villages to release the women from drudgery of manual dehusking. This will save a lot of time and energy given to paddy processing. The people from lower Bonda villages used to carry paddy on their shoulder for dehusking. Now they are very happy with the technological intervention.

Community Mobilisation Programme



Bondas are known to be one of the most reclusive tribes of India. Their interaction with other tribals is limited to the weekly *haat*/market. Developmental initiative needs a lots of technical interventions. Vikash team lead by Sadananda Pradhan the team leader and his colleagues Prassana Kumar Pradhan, Ethel Reeta Kullu, Manaswini Mohapatra, Pravat khosla, Sumant Cheti, Raj kumar Khora, Saroj Pattanaik organized community mobilisation programmes in all the 48 adopted villages in Bonda hills. The purpose was to sensitize the community to plan their developmental agenda and execute them collectively. Besides there was focus on promoting nutrition sensitive agriculture.

Wall paintings have been drawn to sensitize the community on the broad developmental agendas of - improved access to land, sustainable natural resource management, improved agricultural technologies, financial inclusion, market accessibility, improved productivity, accessing government programmes etc. The indigenous community appreciated pictorial campaigns made through wall paintings. The wall paintings have been made in school buildings, Panchayat Office, community halls etc in the Bonda Hills.
